

## Invitation Letter **Olympic Hopes Competition**

The Hungarian Fencing Federation organizes the Olympic Hopes Competition in the season 2022/23 in cadets men's and women's foil, on 15-16. October 2022.

Goal of the competition: is to further deepen the cooperation between the V4 countries in the field of sports. For this reason in 2022, Hungary, Poland, the Czech Republic and Slovakia will organize competitions in 43 different sports as an Olympic Hopes Competition. Part of this series is the cadets fencing competition for the V4 countries and for all other invited nations.

Date of the competition: 15-16. October, 2022.

Venue: Gerevich Aladár National Sports Hall (H-1146 Budapest, Istvánmezei út 3-5.)

Schedule: (two separate individual events on two days)

Saturday, 15. Oct., 2022. cadet men's foil individual: 10:00

> cadet women's foil individual: 14:00

Sunday, 16. Oct., 2022. cadet men's foil individual: 9:00

> cadet women's foil individual: 13:00

Entries: Entries have to be sent via email to benedek.soproniszabo@hunfencing.hu before the end of the deadline for entries, on the attached form.

Deadline for entries: 13. October, 2022.

**Registration:** at least 30 minutes before the start of the competition.

Entry fee: 3500 HUF/person/event

Material control: fencing equipment will be checked before the competition (No name on the back of the fencers is required but for security reasons FIE equipment must be used).

Formula: according to the Rules of the FIE.

**Prizes:** the finalists receive medals and cups.

**Doctor:** The organizer will provide medical personnel during the competition.

Miscellaneous: the organizers will not take responsibility for the personal belongings of the participants, accompanying persons and spectators.
